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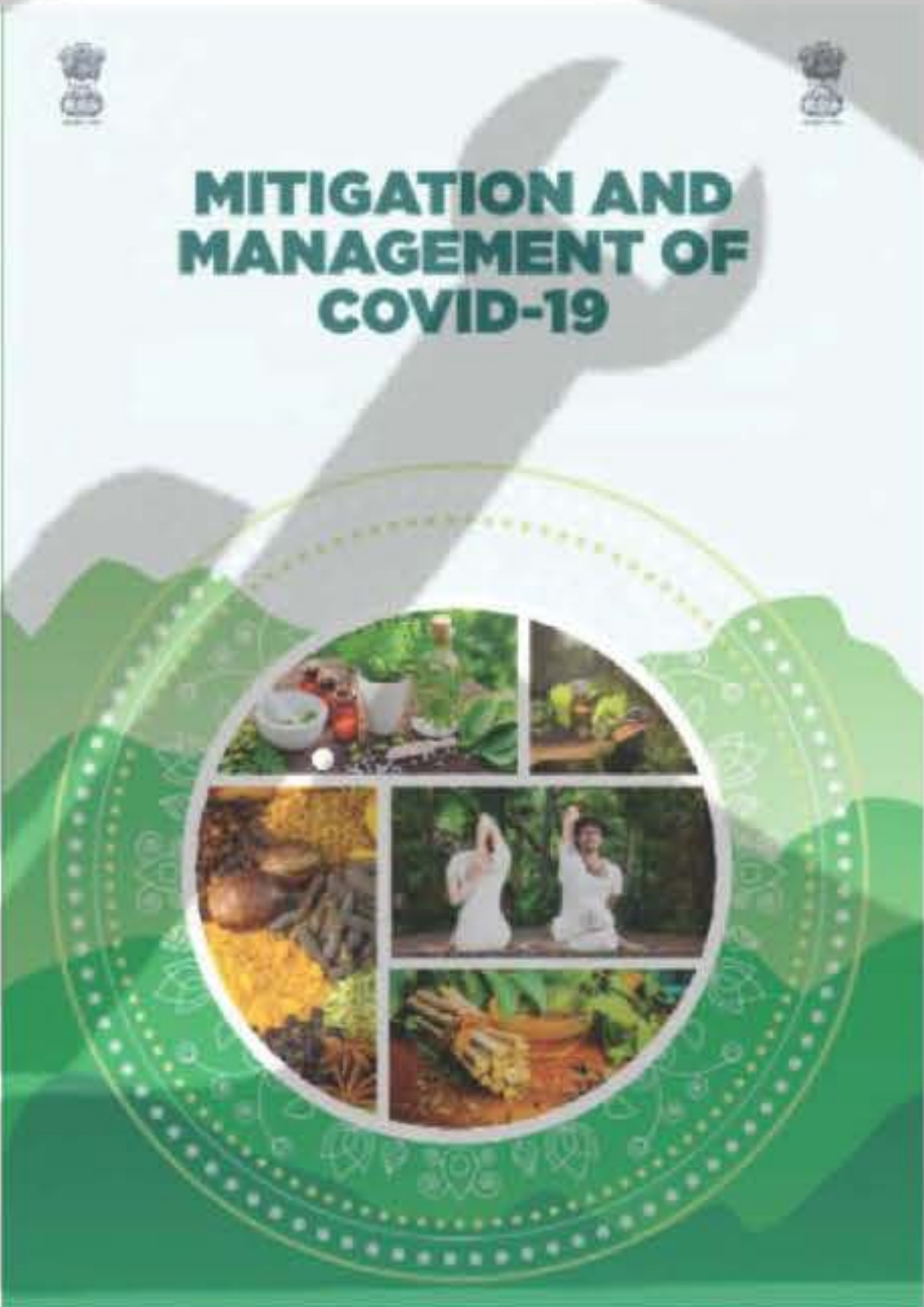
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COVID PROPHYLAXIS & MANAGEMENT THROUGH AYUSH INTERVENTIONS

The COVID-19 pandemic is one of the major health crises of recent times, affecting nations across the globe. The magnitude of the crisis has demanded stakeholders - local, international, and global - to join hands and pool available resources in order to contain the pandemic with more precision. India's response to COVID-19 has been distinct in the sense that the pandemic not only necessitated innovations in modern medicine and health infrastructure, but also propelled the popularity of the country's ancient practice of medicines.

India has six recognized ancient systems of medicine - (i) Ayurveda, (ii) Yoga and Naturopathy (iii) Unani (iv) Siddha (v) Sowa Rigpa (vi) Homoeopathy collectively called the Ayush. The Ministry of Ayush is the nodal ministry dealing with the Indian systems of medicine and healing practices. The Indian System of Medicine (ISM) has a long history of usage in our country. An independent Department of Indian Systems of Medicine and Homoeopathy (ISM&H) was established under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) in 1995. Later in 2003, the department was rechristened as the Department of Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha, and Homoeopathy with the acronym Ayush. Sowa Rigpa was added further to this acronym. On 9th November 2014, the Department of Ayush was granted the status of a ministry. The Ministry of Ayush (MoA) thus came into existence with the mandate to ensure optimal



development, propagation, and popularization of Ayush systems at national and international levels.

The MoA has taken several initiatives to strengthen the fight against COVID in India right from the beginning of the pandemic. The MoA nudged the States and UTs towards utilizing Ayush resources such as Ayush services, infrastructure, and modalities for containing and managing COVID-19. The Ministry has issued various advisories, guidelines, protocols, and notifications related to self-care, prevention, management of COVID-19 and post-COVID cases, telemedicine, Ayush industry, research, and so on. The Ministry conducted several COVID-related awareness programmes, webinars, and training. Ministry of Ayush joined hands with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) and various State and Union Territories to mitigate COVID-19 from time to time. Ayush COVID community support helpline, Ayush Sanjeevani mobile App, and "AYUSH for Immunity" campaign are some of the other important initiatives of the MoA. The MoA has undertaken several R&D initiatives to harness the potential of Ayush systems to contain the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Indian States and Union Territories have taken various initiatives and adopted practices based on the directives issued by the MoA from time to time. Further, several states have also taken various new initiatives and innovations. The State Ayush Departments partnered with the Department of Health & Family Welfare to mitigate and manage the COVID-19 pandemic. The broad areas of intervention and initiatives undertaken by the States/UTs include the utilization of Ayush Human

The Indian education system is witnessing transformation in the era of information and communication technology (ICT). There has been a sea change in teaching, learning and evaluation process from school to higher education level with the use of various ICT tools in line with the Digital India initiative. The entire scenario is thus being reinvented in a more innovative, flexible, effective and experiential manner.

The Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India, has undertaken a number of reforms in order to transform the country's education system. SWAYAM is one such initiative. SWAYAM stands for Study Webs of Active-Learning for Young Aspiring Minds. This national program is based on MOOCs (Massive Open Online Course) platform. It is designed to achieve three fundamental principles of the New Education Policy viz, Access, Equity and Quality.

SWAYAM provides teaching-learning resources through an online platform. It is free and broadly covers a variety of courses in social science, humanities, science, commerce, performing arts, engineering, technology, law, medicine, and agriculture etc. Nine national coordinators have been entrusted with the responsibility to design, produce and deliver best online courses across the country. The nine national coordinators include (i) NPTEL (National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning), (ii) CEC (Centre for Education

and Communication), (iii) AICTE (All India Council for Technical Education), (iv) IGNOU (Indira Gandhi National Open University), (v) IIMB (Indian Institute of Management-Bangalore), (vi) NITTTR (National Institute of Technical Teachers Training & Research), (vii) UGC (University Grants Commission), (viii) NIOS

(National Institute of Open Learning), (ix) NCERT (National Council of Educational Research & Training). The responsibility for conducting the exams for various Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) has been assigned to the National Testing Agency (NTA). For most of the courses, exams are conducted every semester through computer-based or hybrid mode.

According to figures available on SWAYAM portal, currently a total 8082 online courses are being offered through 203 partnering institutions. The student enrolment for these courses is 2,79,56,971. Whereas, registration for the examinations is 22,06,713 and successful certification is 11,77,076. Here it is important to

increasing participation in social and political processes will prove decisive. At the grassroots level, we have more than 14 lakh elected women representatives in Panchayati Raj Institutions. Our daughters are the biggest hope for the nation. Some of them brought laurels for the country at the recently held Commonwealth Games. From becoming fighter pilots to space scientists, our daughters are scaling great heights.

- When the environment is facing new challenges, we must remain determined to preserve all that makes India beautiful. Conserving water, soil and bio-diversity is our duty towards our children. Caring for Mother Nature has been part and parcel of Indian culture. With our traditional lifestyle, we Indians can show the way to the rest of the world. Yoga and Ayurveda are India's invaluable gifts to the world. Their popularity is on the rise all over the globe.

- Our beloved country has given us everything we have in our life. We should pledge to give everything we can for the sake of safety, security, progress and prosperity of our country. Our existence will become meaningful only in building a glorious India. The great nationalist poet Kuvempu, who enriched Indian literature through Kannada language, had written:

Naanu aliwe, Neenu aliwe
Namma elubugal mele
Mooduvudu - Mooduvudu
Navabharatda leele

Which means:

'I will pass
So will you
But on our bones will arise
The great tale of a new India'

This is a clarion call of the nationalist poet for making total sacrifice for the motherland and upliftment of fellow citizens. To follow these ideals is my special appeal to the youth of the country who are going to build the India of 2047.

PM Shri Narendra Modi's Independence Day Speech

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addressed the Nation from the ramparts of the Red Fort on the occasion of 76th Independence Day on 15th August 2022. He addressed several issues pertaining to the aspirations of India and the challenges facing the country. Below are the key highlights of his speech.

Remembering the Heroes

- All the countrymen are deeply indebted to Pujya Bapu, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, Babasaheb Ambedkar, Veer Savarkar, who devoted their entire life fulfilling their duty towards the nation. This country is grateful to Mangal Pandey, Tantiya Tope, Bhagat Singh, Sukhdev, Rajguru, Chandrashekhar Azad, Ashfaq Ulla Khan, Ram Prasad Bismil and countless such revolutionaries who shook the foundation of British rule.
- This nation is grateful to those brave women, be it Rani Lakshmi Bai, Jhalkari Bai, Durga Bhabhi, Rani Gaidinliu, Rani Chennamma, Begum Hazrat Mahal, Velu Nachiyar, who showed the mettle of women power of India.
- Today is an opportunity to pay homage to countless such great men like Dr. Rajendra Prasad, Nehru, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, Shyama Prasad Mookerjee, Lal Bahadur Shastri, Deendayal Upadhyay, Jai Prakash Narayan, Ram Manohar Lohia, Acharya Vinoba Bhave, Nanaji Deshmukh, Subramania Bharati who fought the war of Independence and built the country after Independence.
- When we talk about the freedom struggle, we cannot forget to take pride of our tribal society living in forests. There are countless names like Bhagwan Birsa Munda, Sidhu-Kanhu, Alluri Sitarama Raju, Govind Guru, who became the voice of freedom movement and inspired my tribal brothers and sisters, mothers and youth in the remotest jungles to live and die for the motherland.
- As part of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' celebrations, an attempt was made to bring to light the contributions of great men whose names, due to some or the other reason, did not find mention in the history of India's freedom struggle. As a result of these attempts, today the nation got the opportunity to remember and pay tributes to those unsung heroes.
- The 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' also gives us an opportunity to recall the contributions made by the army personnel, police personnel, bureaucrats, public representatives, administrators of the local self-governments, state administration or central administration in the last 75 years, either protecting the country of fulfilling the country's resolves.



- Today we must also recall the contributions made by the crores of citizens of the country who have done everything possible to take the country forward despite various challenges. As the country completes 75 years of Independence, there are hopes and aspirations for change that every citizen has been yearning for and hoping that their wait will soon be over. I believe that the governments and institutions should work towards fulfilling the aspirations of the citizens so that they do not have to wait any longer. The first dawn of this 'Amrit Kaal' presents a golden opportunity for us to fulfill the citizen's aspirations for change.

Tri Shakti and Panch Pran

- The *Tri-Shakti* (three powers) - aspirations, renaissance and expectations of the world - fuel India's journey. In our journey of 75 years, we have shown to the world that when there is political stability, dynamism in policies, speed in decision making, ubiquity and universal trust, then everyone becomes a partner in development. We started our journey with the mantra of 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas', but gradually the countrymen have added more colours to it with 'Sabka Vishwas' and 'Sabka Prayas.'
- I believe we must focus our attention on the 'Panch Pran' (five resolves) for the coming 25 years. And we must take up the responsibility of fulfilling all the dreams of the freedom fighters by embracing those 'Panch Pran' by 2047 when the country celebrates 100 years of Independence. The 'Panch Pran' of 'Amrit Kaal' must be (i) realising the goal of developed India (ii) removing all traces of colonial mindset (iii) taking pride in our roots (iv) strengthening unity (v) inculcating sense of duty among citizens.

Strength of Collective Consciousness

- Recently, we witnessed some

events which embodied the collective consciousness of the Indian society. This awakening of consciousness, this renaissance, is our greatest asset. The way the country set about celebrating the journey of the Tricolour (*Har Ghar Tiranga*), even the leading experts of social science could not have predicted. *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav* also entails a plan of building 75 Amrit Sarovars in every district of the country. With their own efforts, the people are running a massive campaign for water conservation in their respective villages.

- When I first spoke about cleanliness during my first speech, the entire country embraced it. Everyone took up cleanliness in mission mode according to their capacities to the extent that I now notice a sense of antipathy in the mind of the public towards filthiness. Freedom from open defecation has become possible in India today.
- When the world was in a dilemma, this is the country which crossed the target of 200 crore COVID vaccinations in a time-bound manner and broke all the previous records.
- Providing electricity to every household, providing safe tapped drinking water to every village, achieving 10 percent ethanol blending...all these were not negligible tasks, but we have made great strides on all these fronts.
- In education too, I look with hope the way the new National Education Policy has taken shape with a lot of brainstorming, with the exchange of ideas from various people. The emphasis on skill development will go a long way in giving us the strength to break the shackles of slavery.
- Today we are witnessing the building of an ecosystem for Digital India. We are looking at Start-Ups. This is that pool of

talent who lives in Tier-2 and Tier-3 cities or in villages and mostly belongs to poor families. These are our youngsters who are coming before the world today with new innovations and discoveries.

India: the World's New Hope

- Today the world is discussing about holistic health care. But when they talk about holistic health care, they turn to India's Yoga, Ayurveda and India's holistic lifestyle. This is our legacy that we are sharing with the world.
- Today, when it comes to food and nutrition, coarse paddy and millets have become household items across the globe as a result of which this year the world is celebrating 'International Millet Year.' This too is our legacy that we have shared with the world. It is the hard work and perseverance of our small farmers that made the world appreciate our heritage. Let us learn to be proud of these achievements while keeping in mind that we have a lot more to offer to the world.
- Today the world is facing a severe crisis due to conflicts caused by the attitude of one upmanship- the reason of all tensions. We have the wisdom to resolve this. Our scholars have said '*Ekam Sat Vipra Bahudha Vadanti*' meaning that absolute Truth is one but it is manifested differently. This is our glory.
- We are the people who have been on the path of social good not only for our people but the whole world by believing in "sarve bhavantu sukhinah, sarve santu niramayah". It is ingrained in our values that we shall pray for the prosperity and happiness of all. We shall pray that all of mankind be free from illness, may all see what is auspicious, and may no one suffer.

India's March towards Aatmanirbharta

- Today is also the birth

anniversary of Maharishi Aurobindo. I bow at the feet of that great man who gave us the mantra of 'Swadeshi to Swaraj' and 'Swaraj to Suraj'. Carrying forward this mantra, we have launched '*Aatma Nirbhar Bharat*' which should become the responsibility of every citizen, every government and every unit of society.

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- Speaking of the PLI (Production Linked Incentive) scheme, people from around the world are coming to India to try their luck. Be it manufacturing of electronic goods or mobile phones, today the country is progressing at a very fast pace. Which Indian wouldn't be proud when our Brahmos is exported to the world? Today the Vande Bharat train and our metro coaches are becoming objects of attraction for the world.
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- India has opened up its space sector and has come up with the most progressive policy regarding drones. We have opened up new doors of opportunities for the youth of the country. I also call upon the private sector to come forward. We have to dominate the world. One of the dreams of a self-reliant India is to ensure that India does not lag behind in fulfilling the needs of the world. We have to take our products to the world with '*Zero Defect, Zero Effect*.'

COVID PROPHYLAXIS & MANAGEMENT ...

Resources, infrastructure, digital platforms and telemedicine, Ayush prophylactic and therapeutic intervention for COVID and Post-COVID cases, research studies, and facilitation of Ayush industries.

Utilization of Ayush Human Resources & Infrastructure

Infrastructure and Human Resources are the key pillars for efficient healthcare service delivery. It was evident during the first and the second wave of COVID-19 that there was a significant burden on all healthcare facilities, resulting in greater resource requirement. The MoA collaborated with the MoHFW to increase the pool of available HR and to utilize Ayush HR as COVID warriors for managing COVID-19 with various identified roles. The two ministries jointly provided training to Ayush master trainers. Further, Ayush personnel also obtained training at the Integrated Government Online Training (IGOT) portal. Approximately 28,473 Ayush HR were deployed for COVID-19-related healthcare services by various States/UTs.

The MoA advised the States and UTs to utilize available country-wide Ayush infrastructure, including more than 50,000 beds, 750 hospitals of Ayush colleges, 86 clinical facilities of Research Councils, and National Institutes (under the MoA), by appropriately converting them into COVID Care Centres or hospitals.

The State health authorities utilized Ayush HR and infrastructure as per the situation and need. Ayush HR fulfilled various roles, including surveillance, contact tracing, testing, telephonic consultations, distribution of medicines, counselling, vaccinations, and duties in various capacities at COVID facilities, quarantine centers, helpdesks, post-COVID clinics, and other facilities. Ayush HR was also a part of rapid

response teams, district vigilance committees for monitoring bed and oxygen supply, district surveillance teams, and involved in physical and tele-triaging in various States. The State and UT Governments utilized Ayush infrastructure as fever clinics, vaccination centers, COVID Care Centre (CCCs), COVID Health Centers, and Post-COVID Clinics.

Ayush HR was deployed at various levels of the healthcare system, including civil hospitals, CCCs, Dedicated COVID Hospitals (DCH), Dedicated COVID Health Centers (DCHC), Tele-counselling centers, and mobile healthcare service delivery in different capacities in Gujarat. Ayush hospitals were also converted into CCCs. Maharashtra converted 182 Ayush facilities into CCCs and 144 into quarantine centers. Ayush HR was deployed at CCCs, shelter homes, isolation wards, and COVID hospitals in Goa. Kerala formed the State Ayurveda COVID Response Cell (SACRC), and a total of 1206 Ayur Raksha Clinics were opened to tackle the pandemic. Post-COVID complications management was also done through 45+ Siddha hospitals and clinics. The Himachal Ayush Department formed Quick Response Teams (QRTs) at the State, district, and sub-divisional levels as well as in regional Ayurvedic hospitals and educational institutions. Uttar Pradesh Government established Integrated COVID Command and Control Centres in all districts headed by the district nodal officers. The Delhi Government established dedicated Ayush COVID Healthcare Centres at hospitals of Ayush teaching institutes and established 175 Ayush post-COVID Centres. Siddha CCCs were operationalized across the State in Tamil Nadu. General OPDs and IPDs were equipped specially to

tackle post-COVID-19 cases in Bihar.

Ayush Prophylactic, Therapeutic Interventions, R&D Initiatives

Prevention is one of the critical measures for battling COVID-19. States and UTs have followed the directives issued by the MoA and taken several initiatives to safeguard the community, COVID warriors/ frontline workers, quarantined individuals, and management of COVID/ Post-COVID cases. Further, Ayush interventions were utilized in many States/UTs in the management of COVID-19 cases as an adjuvant to standard care. States like Karnataka and Maharashtra have also developed state-specific guidelines for the prevention of COVID-19. States and UTs extensively distributed the immunity-boosting Ayush medications. It has been observed in the recently released report, namely "Mitigation and Management of COVID-19: Compendium of Ayush-Based Practices from Indian States and Union Territories" by NITI Aayog, that the number of cumulative beneficiaries of Ayush prophylactic medicines in 15 States/UTs is approximately 9.7 crore. Additionally, Andhra Pradesh and Gujarat have distributed approximately 22.17 crore doses of Ayush prophylactic medicine. Few States and UTs like Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Kerala, and Delhi also undertook research studies related to the prevention and management of COVID-19 through Ayush intervention.

Digital Platform & Telemedicine

Digital platforms and telemedicine services played a vital role during the testing time of the COVID-19 pandemic. They have emerged and served as a safe mode of interaction between healthcare workers, the public, and patients. The States and UTs extensively utilized digital platforms to disseminate information related to self-care

guidelines and monitor COVID-related activities. Ayush-based prophylactic measures like daily regimes, diets, Yoga practices, and awareness about other preventive guidelines were disseminated through television programs, radio talks, social media, mobile apps, animation, and videography. Teleconsultation was provided to the general public for preventive measures, including counselling and reducing the stigma of COVID-19, to home-quarantined and COVID patients.

Several States and UTs issued state-specific helpline numbers and developed mobile Apps for facilitating these services. For instance, Gujarat started a "COVID-19-related Ayush Health Lecture Series". The Telemedicine App "Ayush Qure" was launched to facilitate teleconsultation facility in Madhya Pradesh. The health institutions under the Department of Ayush were linked to this App for wider public utility. Uttarakhand established the COVID Ayush Desk, and in each district, teams were formulated utilizing Ayush Medical Officers for providing the National Clinical Management Protocol and Ayush-based teleconsultation to the COVID-positive patients. A centralized Ayush Desk was also established at the Directorate for training, monitoring, data collection, and reporting. An Aarogya Sampark Dashboard was created for real-time tracking of COVID-19 related efforts of Ayush in Jammu and Kashmir. Bihar State Ayush Society made the Ayush Teleconsultation App to accelerate the teleconsultation services. Uttar Pradesh developed the Ayush Kavach App to provide direct consultation with specialized Ayush doctors. Additionally, live Yoga sessions were telecast every morning at 0800 hrs for patients and the community, and a live "AYU-SAMVAD" programme was carried out every evening for the prevention of COVID-19 and other common diseases.

Support for Ayush Industry

For successful implementation of prophylactic and therapeutic interventions, it was crucial to have an uninterrupted supply of medicines. Several States and UTs facilitated the process of licensing/approval and renewal of licenses for manufacturing Ayush healthcare products, especially immunity boosters, Ayush-64, and sanitizers. For instance, 100 private Ayurveda medicines manufacturers were issued temporary licences to produce hand sanitizers and Ayush Kwath, to meet the increased demand in Rajasthan. Himachal Pradesh issued approval for the manufacturing of sanitizers, hand wash, and Ayush Kwath to 60 firms for 382 formulations.

Way Forward

The Central Government has played a vital role in mitigating and managing COVID-19. There was a need to pool the available resources as the healthcare system was overwhelmed during the pandemic. The States substantially utilized Ayush HR and infrastructure to manage COVID-19. The various States and UTs have followed directives issued by the MoA and implemented them in their States as per the feasibility, while many have also done some innovations. Some States have adopted State-specific policies and launched various programmes to prevent and manage COVID-19 and post-COVID-19 cases.

In order to synergize the public healthcare system, the States need to review the policies further to strengthen the traditional healthcare systems in the country. Integrating evidence-based Ayush services with the modern systems can be a model to tackle the unique health challenges of the current century.

August 29 is celebrated as the National Sports Day in India which is also the birth anniversary of hockey wizard Dhyan Chand. National Sports Day is a timely reminder for the need for sporting activities in life and to honour the remarkable achievements of all those exemplary sportspersons who have represented India in various sports and made our nation proud. Not only that, this Day also applauds the support given by the families, coaches and support staff towards the success of the talented athletes of our nation.

Why we Celebrate National Sports Day?

The primary goal of this Day is to popularise sports and support sporting talent in India. At a time when India is surpassing conventional ways, adopting new disciplines and building a momentum where more and more of our sportspersons are gaining global recognition, is it important to keep that momentum going by infusing the youth with energy and replenish it with supporting Government policies and schemes. Furthermore, sports builds tenacity and determination among people along with the promotion of health and fitness.

The National Sports Day is also an occasion that sees the nation honour its sporting heroes with recognitions like the Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna (formerly called the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna), Arjuna Award, Dhyan Chand Award and the Dronacharya Award. At a special ceremony held at the Rashtrapati Bhavan, the President of India takes this day to confer these awards.

Who is Major Dhyan Chand?



Hockey player Major Dhyan Chand has reserved a special place for himself in the Indian Sports history. Born in Allahabad (Prayagraj) in Uttar Pradesh on August 29, 1905, as Dhyan Singh, he rose to prominence in the pre-independence period. He was the star of the Indian hockey team that dominated the sport in the years before World War II.

Starting his hockey career with the regimental team of the British Indian Army, a young Dhyan Singh was a special talent whose dedication towards his crafts made in stand out. He used to spend most of the day in regimental duties and practice hockey in the night under the moonlight and that is the reason which earned him the name *Dhyan Chand*.

Dhyan Chand went on to rule the world of hockey with his delightful stick work and understanding of the game that earned him the moniker of 'Hockey Wizard' and 'The Magician'. The hockey legend's career spanned from 1926 to 1948 and ended as one of the greatest hockey players of all time after having represented India 185 matches and scored over 400 goals during this period. He played an important role in helping India complete their first hat-trick of Olympic gold medals with wins at the 1928, 1932 and 1936 Summer Olympics. The Indian Government conferred him with the Padma Bhushan in 1956.

Development of Sports in India

Sports have always been a part of the common life in India for ages. There are several pieces of evidence of the existence of vibrant sports activities in India. Our epics like Ramayana and Mahabharata are full of incidences of sports such as archery, wrestling, horse-riding, chariot-racing, etc. For instance, wrestling has been a highly

popular sport even during the times of Mahabharata. Known as Malla-yuddha, it saw participation from legendary characters such as Bhima, Balram, and Jarasandha - who have been mentioned as the greatest wrestlers in the epic. Today, India is known as a powerhouse in wrestling with several outstanding accolades gained at the international fora - the commonwealth games, the world championships, and the Olympics.

The recent success of India at the Commonwealth Games and the Olympics is commendable - with many firsts added to the kitty. In recent times, the Government of India and State Governments have taken multiple initiatives to groom athletes for professional sports. With the four tools-players' resources, modern training facilities, international exposure and transparency in selection-the Government has given four tools to increase the potential of the players-the Government has increased the potential of our players. The government has also linked sports with fitness and employment of the youth, self-employment and their careers.

The Government of India took a historic step by starting a targeted scheme to achieve top results in the Olympics games. The Target Olympic Podium Scheme, i.e. TOPS, has been a key effort towards India's goal of becoming a Sports Champion. TOPS was launched in 2014 under the aegis of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) to provide financial assistance and other help to athletes in their pursuit of medals in the Olympics and other international sporting events. Sports such as Archery, Badminton, Boxing, Hockey, Shooting, and Wrestling have been recognized as 'high priority' schemes under the scheme.

While the TOPS scheme aimed at polishing existing talent for higher results, the Government of India designed a future-looking scheme to develop a pool of talent from the remotest part of the country through the Khelo India Scheme. Aimed at mainstreaming sports as a tool for national development, economic development, community development, and individual development, the Khelo India scheme was launched in 2018. Today, the Government is spending millions of rupees on the top players on their diet, fitness and training. The Union Government has raised the sports budget from Rs 864 crore in 2014 to Rs 1,992 crore in 2022. Talent is being identified in every corner of the country at a very young age through the Khelo India campaign. Every possible help is being given to such players to make them athletes of the international level.

The Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir is famous for its eternal beauty. It is not just the beauty of mountains that adds to the glory of this place, rather, one can also explore the exquisiteness of handlooms. From weaving very fine designs on the carpets to using vibrant colors on shawls or woollen handlooms, Jammu and Kashmir has spread the magic all over the world. Undoubtedly, the Kashmiri Pashmina shawl is the most famous shawl in the world. Designers use Pashmina material for the shawls as it is warm and soft. In fact, it is the purest form of wool. Sometimes Pashmina is also mixed with silk to give shiny

look to the material. A craze for pashmina shawls, known as shahmina in Kashmir, in the mid-1990s, resulted in high demand for the raw material and the demand exceeded supply. The handloom sector plays a vital role in the country's economy. The production of handloom textile is highly fragmented and labour-intensive. However the sector is faced by manifold challenges such as low productivity, globalization, insufficient working capital, supply chain hurdles, unfair competition with machine-made textile, etc. The handloom sector has to strengthen itself by overcoming these hurdles. Establishing a central network to disseminate vital information to weavers, improving weavers' awareness about availability of finance, sales processes, and setting up handloom institutes in every handloom town are among the steps that will help rejuvenate the sector. The prudent strategy lies in striking a balance between retaining the cultural heritage of the profession and the introduction of modern advanced technology for weavers in the weaving industry.

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Selection Procedure Merit List. The following process will be followed in respect of selection and corresponding merits for written exam, interview and final call letter.
